- Classroom management: Modifying, deleting, adding assignments and resources

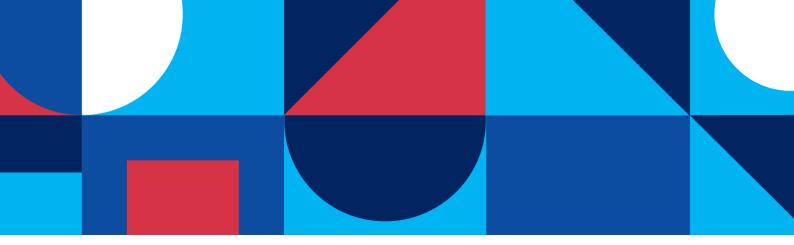
